

Influenza-like-illness (ILI) and Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI) surveillance, <u>Week20 (15th – 21thMay) 2017</u>

Synopsis

The predominant Influenza strains that circulated in this weekwere Influenza A/H3.However, overall incidence of Influenza-like-illness (ILI) and Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI) were 51/ 1000 outpatient visits and 7/ 100 hospitalized patients respectively.

Virological Surveillance




Figure 1: Trend of influenza virus subtypes by week detected from ILI cases (Note: data is till 20thweek)




Figure 2: Trend of influenza virus subtypes by week detected from SARI cases (Note: data is till 20thweek)

Out of thirty-onerespiratory specimens (ILI=24 & SARI = 7) received and tested for influenza viruses by Real Time RT PCR,Influenza A/pdm 09was predominantly detected (Figure 1 & 2). The Influenza viruses were predominantly detected from Central and Western regions (Figure 3).

1. Epidemiological Surveillance

a) ILI and SARI sentinel Surveillance




Figure 4: Average number of ILI and SARI cases reported until week 20 (Data source: Online weekly reporting from sentinel sites).

ILI incidence in the sentinel sites for the week was 51cases per 1000 outpatient visits, which has slightly increasedcompared to the previous week (Figure 4). Samtsehospital has reported the highest ILI cases (127cases) for the week.

SARI incidence in the sentinel sites for the week was 7 cases per 100 admitted cases, which has decreasedcompared to the previous week (Figure 4). Trongsa hospital has reported highest cases (6) of SARI.

b) Age distribution

ILI cases were commonly observed in age group15-29 years, while SARI cases were commonly seen in 0-1 year. Influenza-confirmed ILI cases were commonly seen in 5-14 and15-29 year while SARI lab confirmed was seen in 0-1 years.
